

FIU and NSF are committed to promoting safe, productive research and education environments for current and future scientists. NSF expects all personnel supported by an NSF award to comport themselves in a responsible and accountable manner during the award period of performance whether at FIU, on-line, or outside the organization, such as at field sites or during conferences/workshops.

Effective October 22, 2018, NSF has issued a new term and condition that will require FIU to notify NSF of any findings/determinations of sexual harassment, other forms of harassment or sexual assault regarding an NSF-funded PI or co-PI. The new term and condition will also require FIU to notify NSF if the PI or co-PI is placed on administrative leave or of any administrative action relating to any finding/determination or an investigation of an alleged violation relation to sexual harassment, other forms of harassment, or sexual assault. This term and condition will apply to new awards and any funding amendments made on/after October 22, 2018.

Upon notification, NSF will consult with ORED to determine subsequent action as it relates to the NSF award.
