Subj.: NSF Project Reporting in Fastlane

Date: January 7, 2013

The Division of Research would like to advise the University Research Community that the National Science Foundation (NSF) will be transferring all project reporting from FastLane to Research.gov on March 18th, 2013.

In anticipation of this transfer the NSF will be freezing all project reporting in Fastlane as of February 1st, 2013 and will extend the overdue date for all project reports that are currently scheduled to become overdue between January 31st, 2013 and April 30th, 2013.

After March 18th, 2013 all NSF funded Principal Investigators (PIs) and Co-PIs will use the Project Reporting Dashboard in Research.gov to meet all NSF project reporting requirements, including submission of Final, Annual and Interim Project Reports as well as the required Project Outcomes Report.

The new Project Reporting Dashboard in Research.gov will make it easier for PIs, Co-PIs, and Division of Research personnel to see which reports are due or overdue, and will provide access to all reports submitted to the NSF. PIs, Co-PIs, and Division of Research personnel will continue to use their existing Fastlane credentials to log into Research.gov
