The Florida Department of Education (FL DoEd) has announced the release of the 2015-16 Requests for Proposals (RFP) for competitive projects for the 21st Century Community Learning Centers program (21st CCLC), authorized under Title IV, Part B, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, as amended (<u>http://www.fldoe.org/schools/family-community/activities-programs/21st-century-community-learning-center/rfp.stml</u>).

The FL DoEd has determined that the maximum combined total funding across all 21st CCLC programs, whether they are new or continuing awards, will not exceed \$2 million for Project Year 2015-16 per grantee, therefore limiting the number of submissions that the university can submit.

If any units are considering applying for this program then they must send an email to <u>gutierrr@fiu.edu</u> by 5:00 pm on April 7th, 2015 indicating the title of their program and the proposed school sites they are considering.

Please note that those FIU projects that are currently funded by the 21st CCLC program and are considering submitting a continuation application will be receiving additional instructions from our office.
