Subj.: Electronic Internal Clearance Form (eICF)

The Division of Research would like to advise the University Research Community that the deployment of the Electronic Internal Clearance Form (eICF) has been completed and the paper internal clearance form will no longer be accepted after April 30th, 2012.

As has been previously announced the eICF allows the electronic routing of proposals throughout the entire internal approval process from the PI / Co-PIs, to the Chair, Dean and the Division of Research. As the eICF has been deployed to areas of FIU's research community, the Division of Research has embedded additional, permanent research administrative support to assist the research community with this new endeavor.

The goal of the Division of Research is to enable the university's researchers to focus more of their time and resources on the science during the proposal process and less on the administrative aspects associated with proposal preparations and submissions.

Below is a listing of the eICF Representatives that are available to assist with all aspects of the eICF process including: filling out the eICF online, developing budgets, filling out agency forms, uploading attachments and assisting with electronic routing of proposals for clearance.
