1. Purpose

- 1.1 To outline the proper procedures when an animal is found dead.
- 2. Responsibility

- 4. Guidelines
 - 4.1 When a laboratory animal is found dead the technician on duty takes the cage out of the rack and places it in the animal procedure station.
 - 4.2 Remove the animal and place it in a biohazard bag.
 - 4.3 If the PI needs to collect tissue, write on the bag the following information:
 - 4.3.1 Date, Investigator, Protocol number, Technician name, Cage number
 - 4.3.2 If applicable, descriptive comments about the general condition of the carcass of animal found dead shall also be documented, including the cause of death (if possible).
 - 4.4 Fill out a dead animal cage card with the same information you wrote on the bag.

- 4.5 Place the dead animal card in the card holder of the cage to let the investigators know that an animal has been found dead in that cage.
- 4.6 Place the dead animal in the refrigerator that way the investigator can find it.
- 4.7 Fill out the information required in the Dead Animal Log in Book.
- 4.8 Call the investigator's lab letting them know that a dead animal has been found.
- 4.9 The disposition of moribund animals shall be decided by the Attending Veterinarian in keeping with humane treatment and study protocol requirements.
- 4.10 If the PI doesn't need tissue collected, the animal's carcass is placed in the carcass freezer.
