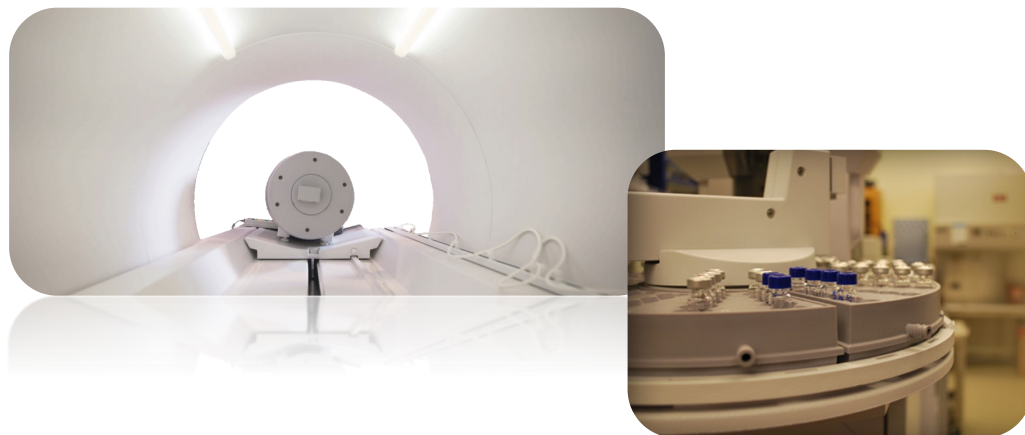


## The scoop on FIU's Research Facilities and Recharge Centers
